RE: Patient Immunisation whilst traveling abroad

Please be advised that all patients who require further supplementary immunization due to the above noted affected batches whilst traveling abroad will be eligible to have the associated costs as outlined below reimbursed by Aventis Pasteur Australia.

Associated costs eligible for reimbursement will be as follows:

- Cost of additional vaccine (supplementary rabies vaccine to complete the recommended course)
- Associated medical consultation fees to have these supplementary doses of vaccine administered.

Patients will be required to pay for the vaccine and the consultation at the time of administration whilst abroad ensuring that they gain invoices and receipts for all associated costs as outlined above.

Upon return, the patient will need to forward request for reimbursement with all the associated receipts to Aventis Pasteur for payment.
