



Work Related Medical Consultations

There are 2 main types of consultation services provided by our doctors. - see table below. All travellers need to have a TRAVEL CONSULT to determine their pre-travel health care - medications, vaccines etc. In addition, if a trip is more than 6 months, or there are specific medical or visa forms required to be completed, the traveller will require a more in depth 'MEDICAL SCREENING' in addition. IE Some patients require BOTH a Travel consult and Medical Screening

*We are able to accommodate whatever medical paperwork is required, however we need to see the paperwork *before the doctors consultation visit*, so we can allocate sufficient time for the visit, and ensure all necessary tests are efficiently organised. Administration fee of \$30 (+GST) is added in cases where more administration and paperwork is required to be complied and completed.

- Vaccines, malaria tablets and other medications are an extra cost (price list available).
- All bills are itemised unless requested otherwise.
- Consultations when travelling for work are not covered by Medicare.
- GST is outlined on our invoice.
- Visa medical costs vary from \$80-\$350 depending on the type of paperwork required.
- Blood tests are usually taken onsite
- Drug & Alcohol screenings may be onsite or at the pathologist depending on the criteria required for test
- As Doctors have to be booked in advance, 24 hours' notice is required for cancellation or the full cost of the Doctors Consultation Fee will apply.
