VACCINE TRIAL **VOLUNTEERS NEEDED**

Would you like to help in a vaccine trial for a vaccine that is not COVID 19?

WE NEED YOU

Japanese encephalitis (JE)

is a dangerous disease in Asia that affects travellers and is spread by mosquitoes.

We are looking for participants 18-45 years of age, who would be prepared to have the Australian registered JE vaccine using a microdose into the skin (ID), to see if this will work just as well, and help advance medical science.

Research involves having an ID dose of JE vaccine and a blood test on first day, and then a second and third visit to our clinic in the Brisbane CBD one month and 2 months later for a blood test each time.

Intradermal vaccination (ID) means giving a tiny dose of the vaccine (0.1ml) into the surface layers of the skin, instead of a bigger dose (0.5ml) deeper into the muscle.

The surface layers of the skin are especially rich in cells that make antibodies... so it has been shown with other vaccines that a smaller dose often works just as well.

> ID is how we often give rabies vaccine, sometimes give influenza vaccine and how we always give the Tuberculosis or TB vaccine.

You will get the results of your blood tests at the end.
