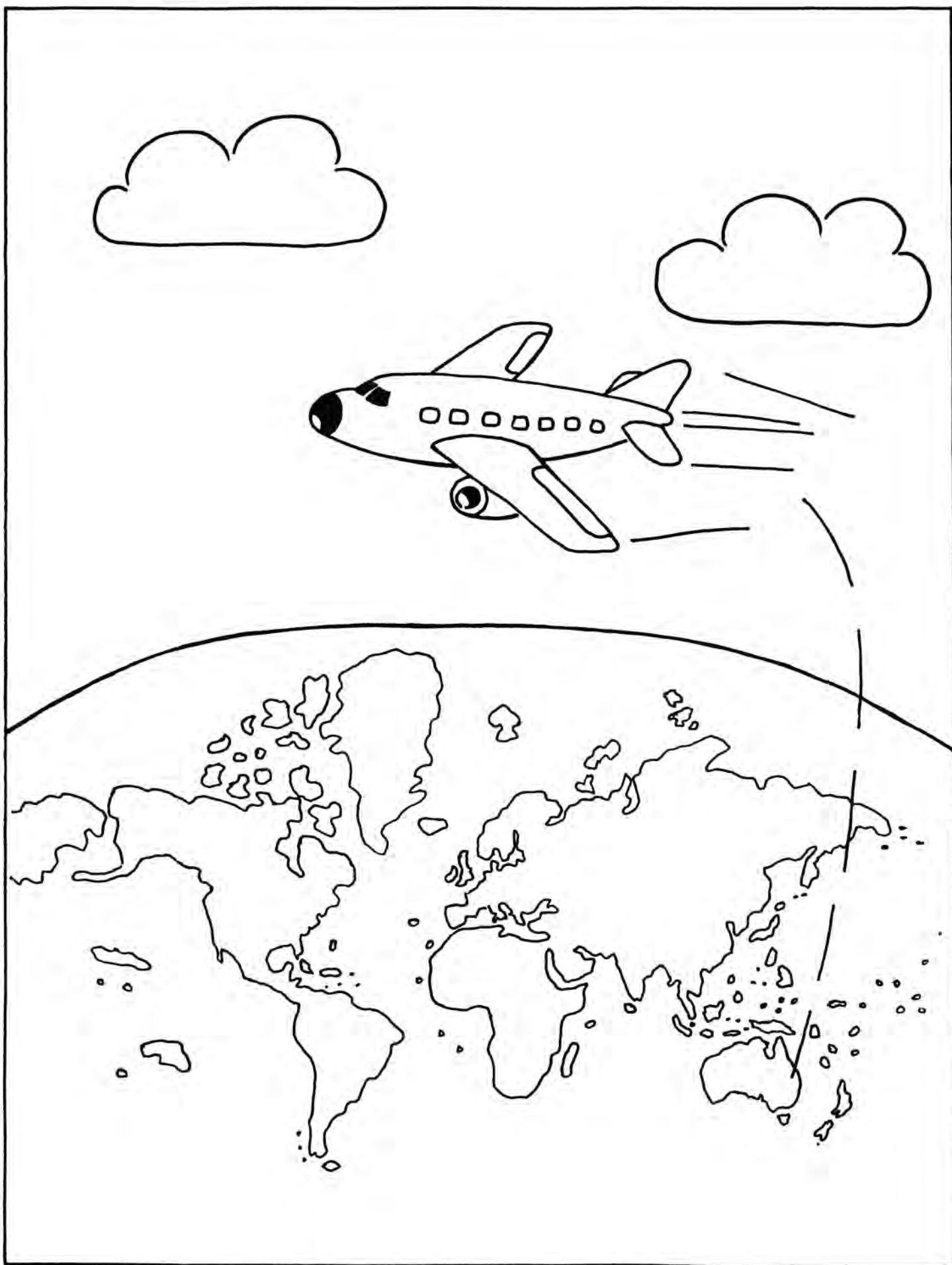

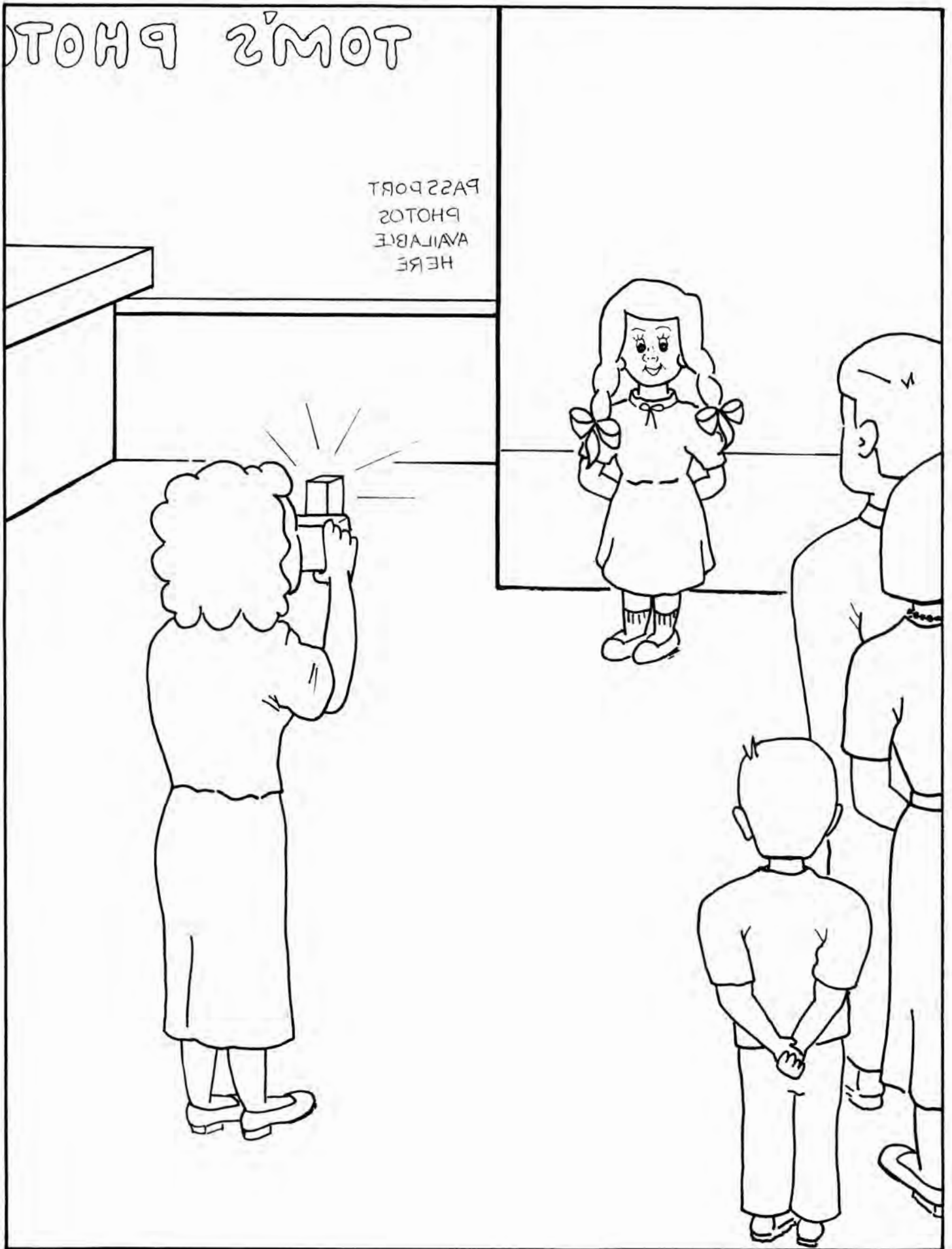
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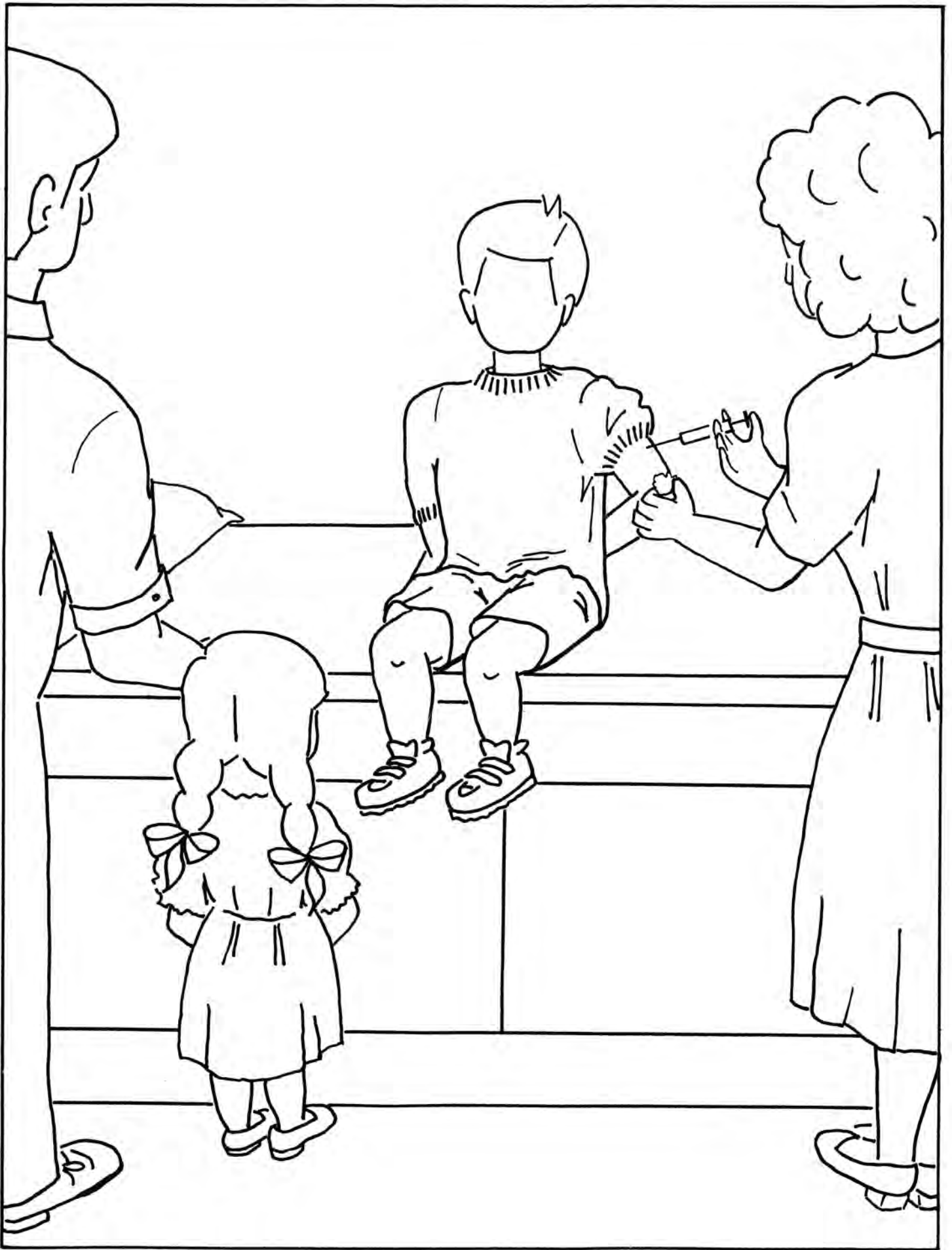
This is the story of Martin and Laura who live with their Mummy and Daddy, their dog, Snowball, their cat, Rustle, and all their toys in a little house in Australia.

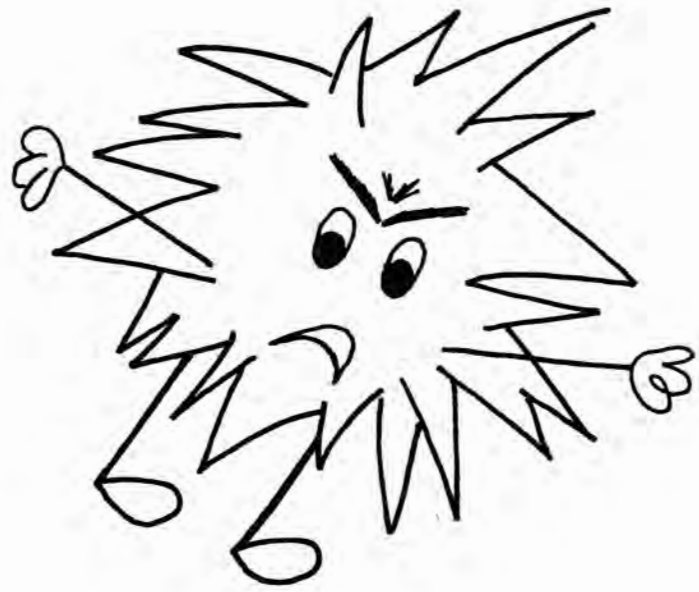
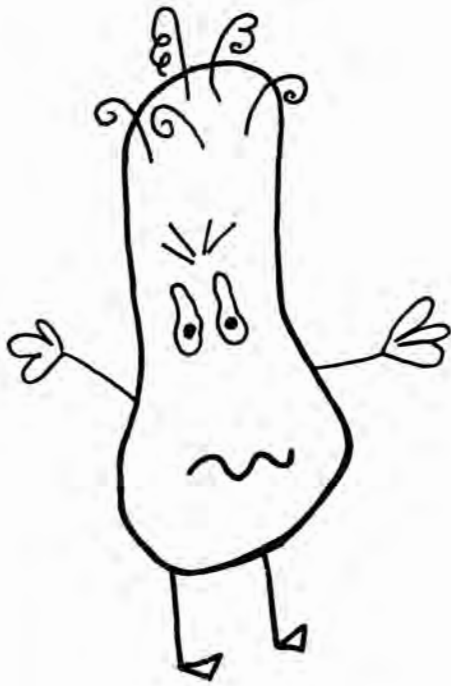
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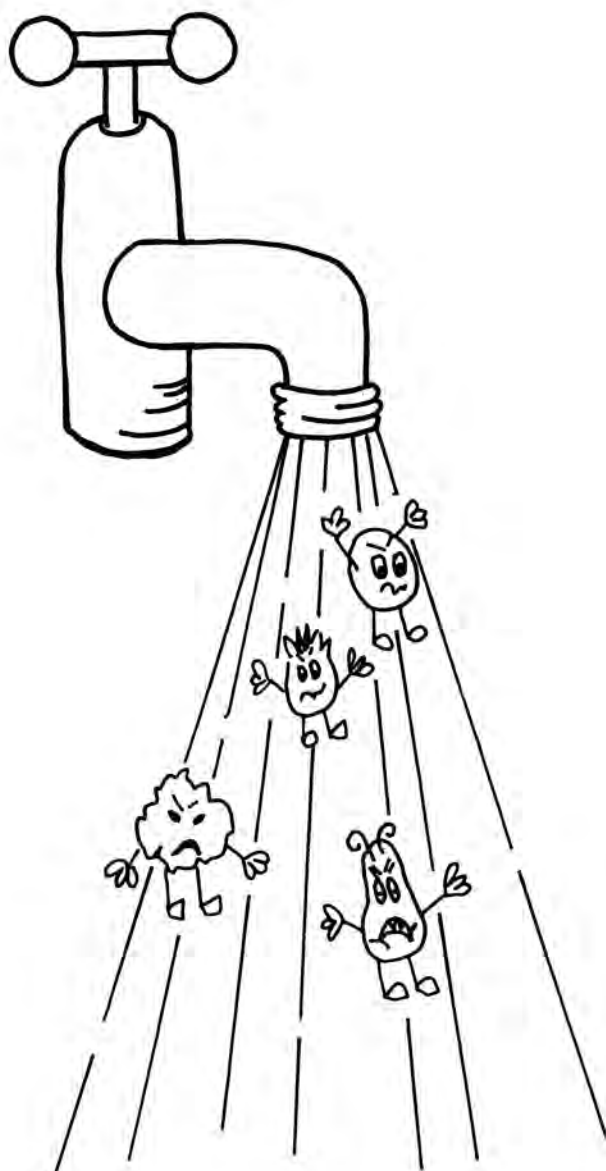
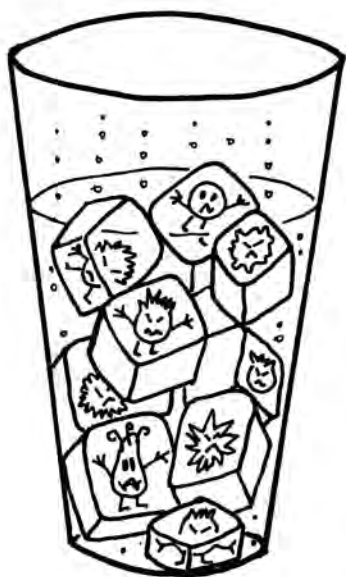
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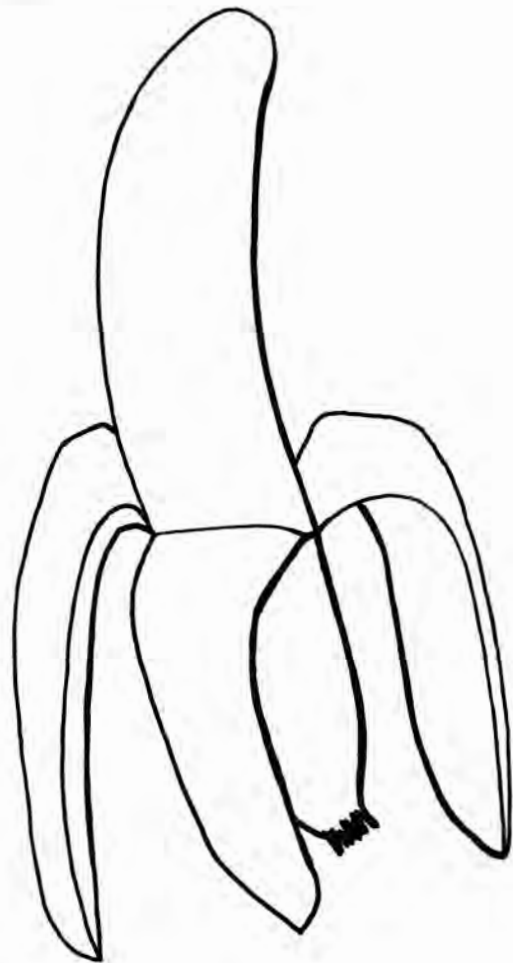
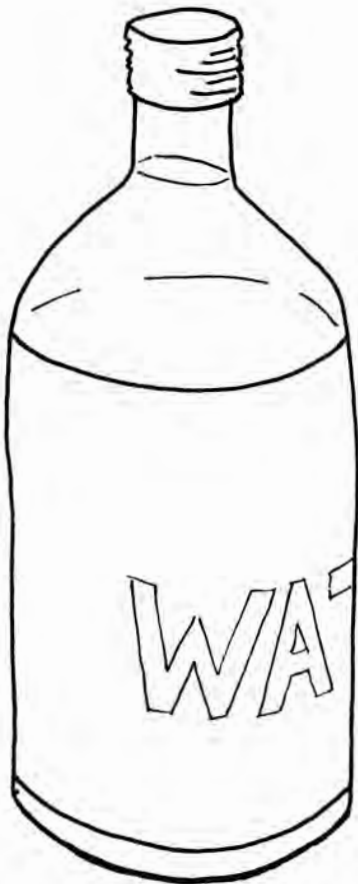
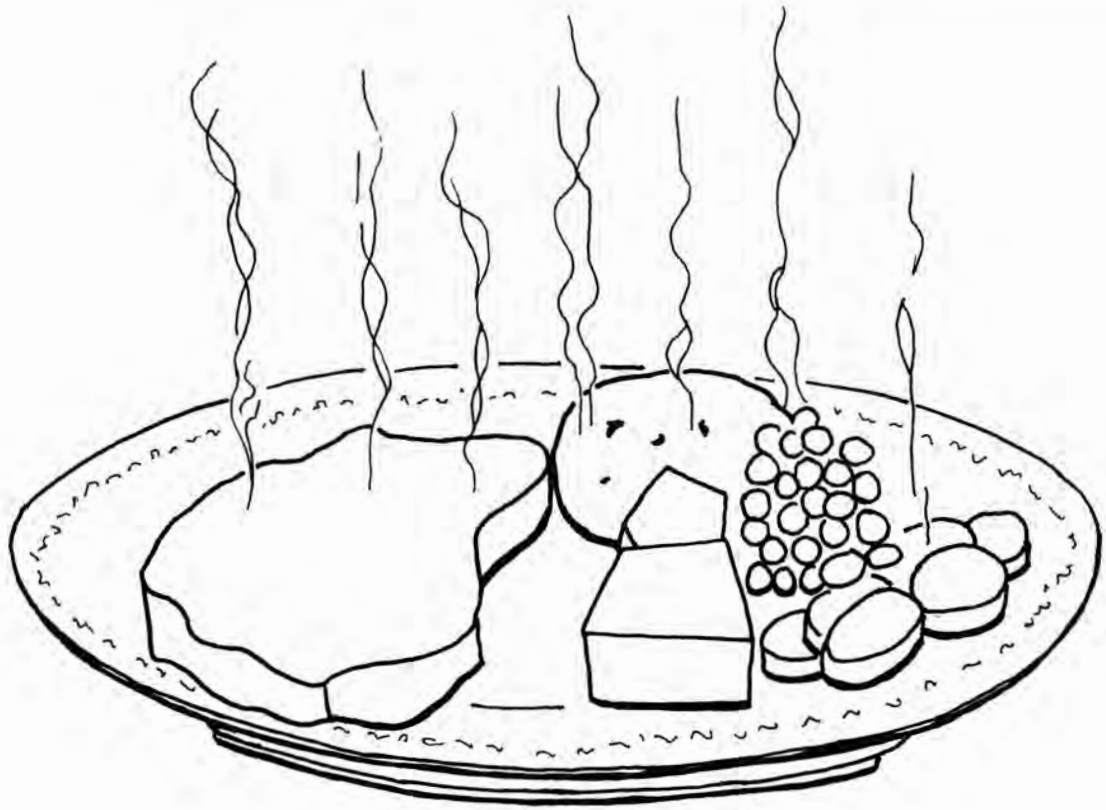
Laura and Martin have lots of needles, so they get lots of stamps in their yellow books. Can you stamp and colour in their yellow book?



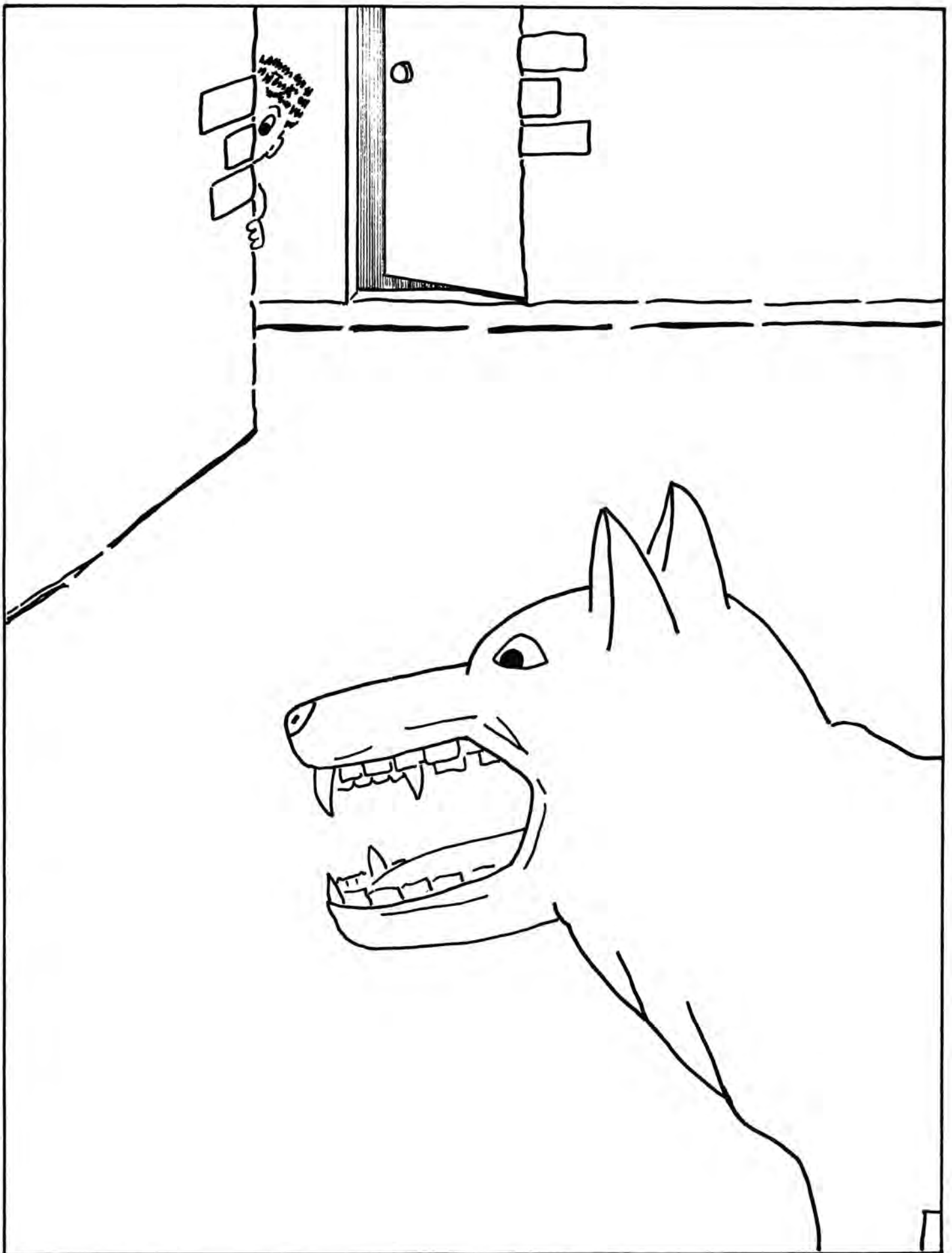
The doctor tells them about germs. Germs can make you very sick. Other countries have different germs from Australia. Here are two germs. Can you draw some more?



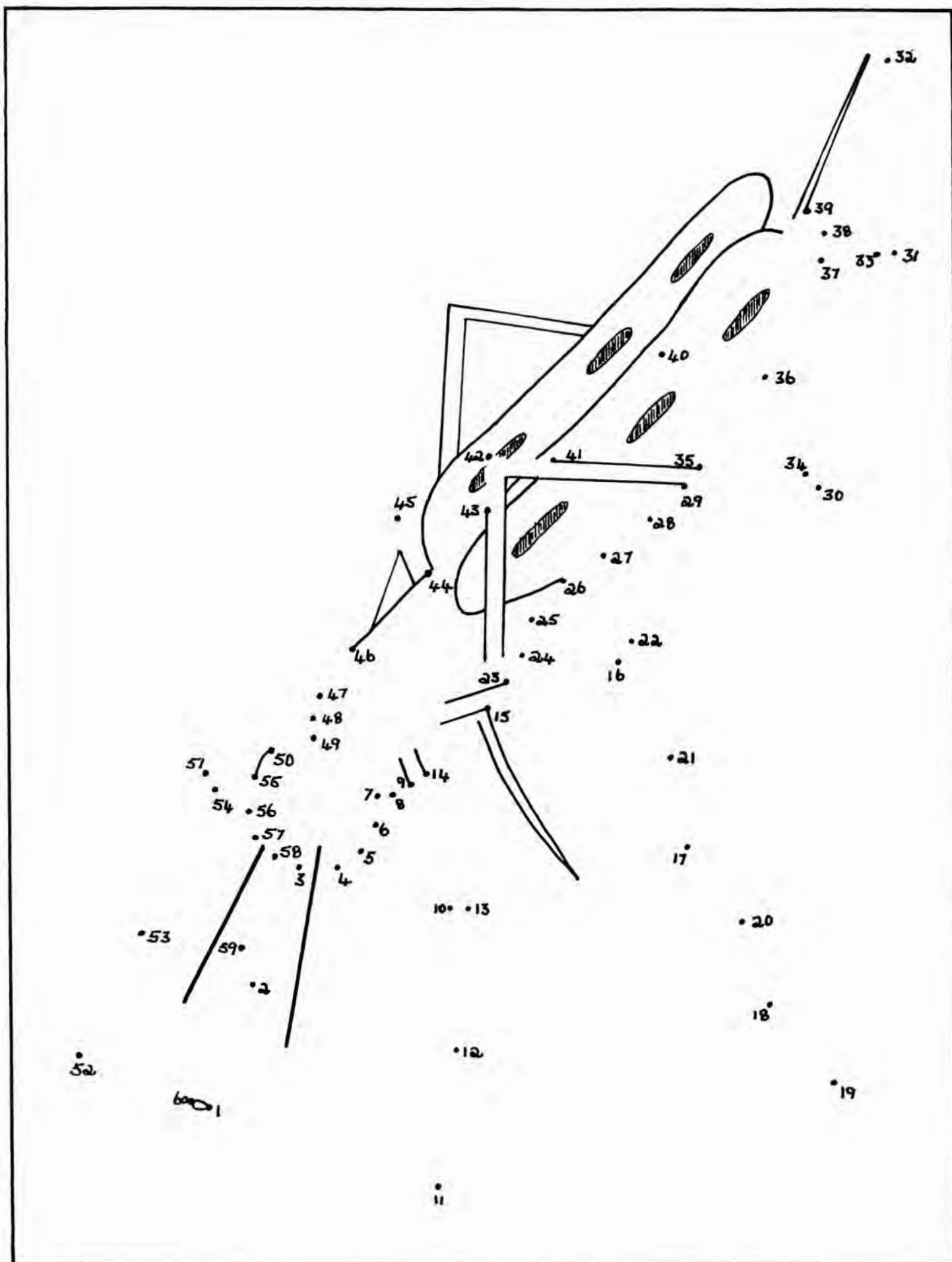
Germs are invisible and can hide in food. Don't eat ice and don't drink from the tap.



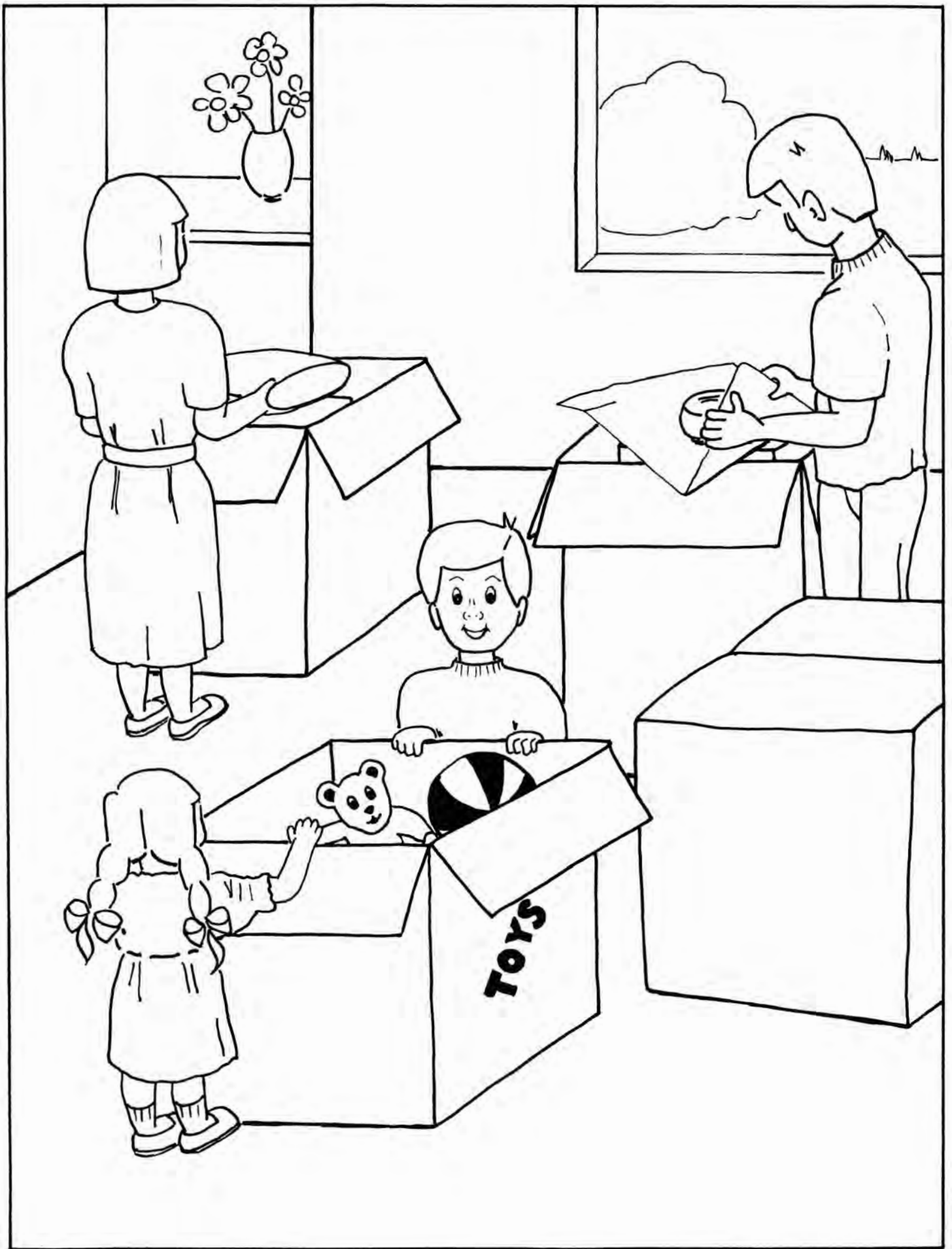
Eat only safe foods - cooked food, bottled drinks and peeled fruit.



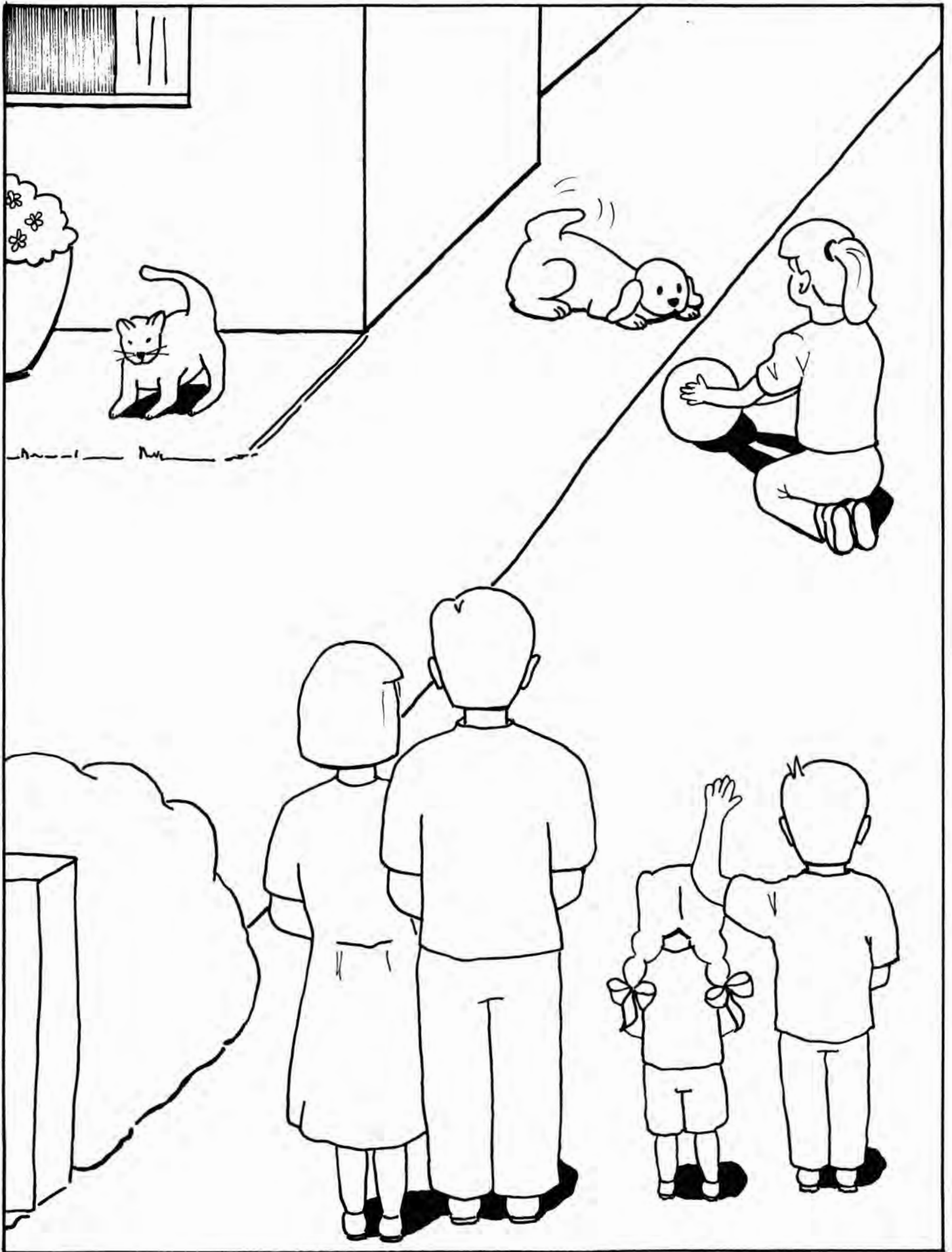

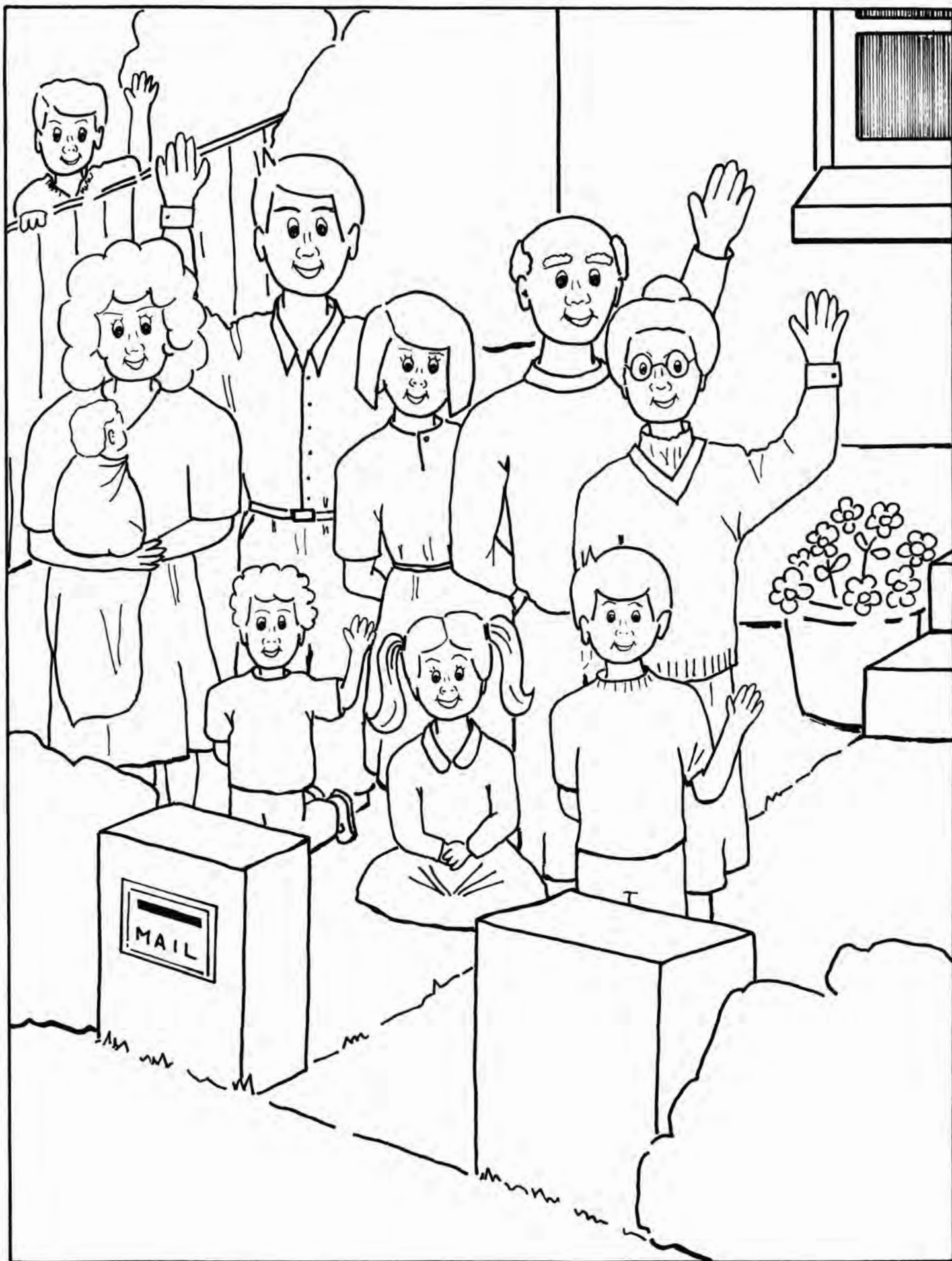
Join the dots to find out what animal carries diseases like malaria.
Don't get bitten !!



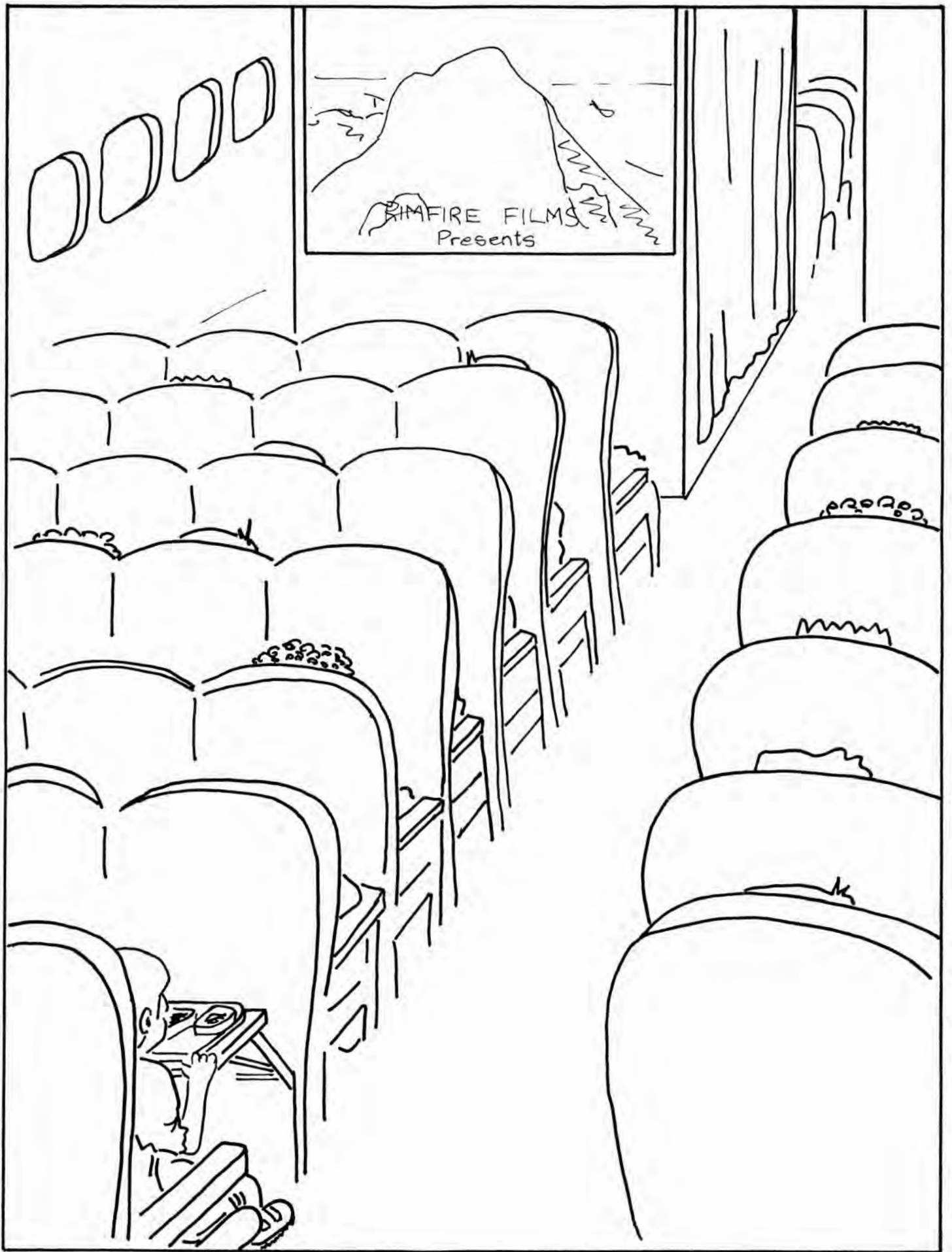
Mummy and Daddy are very busy packing up. Laura and Martin help pack their toys.



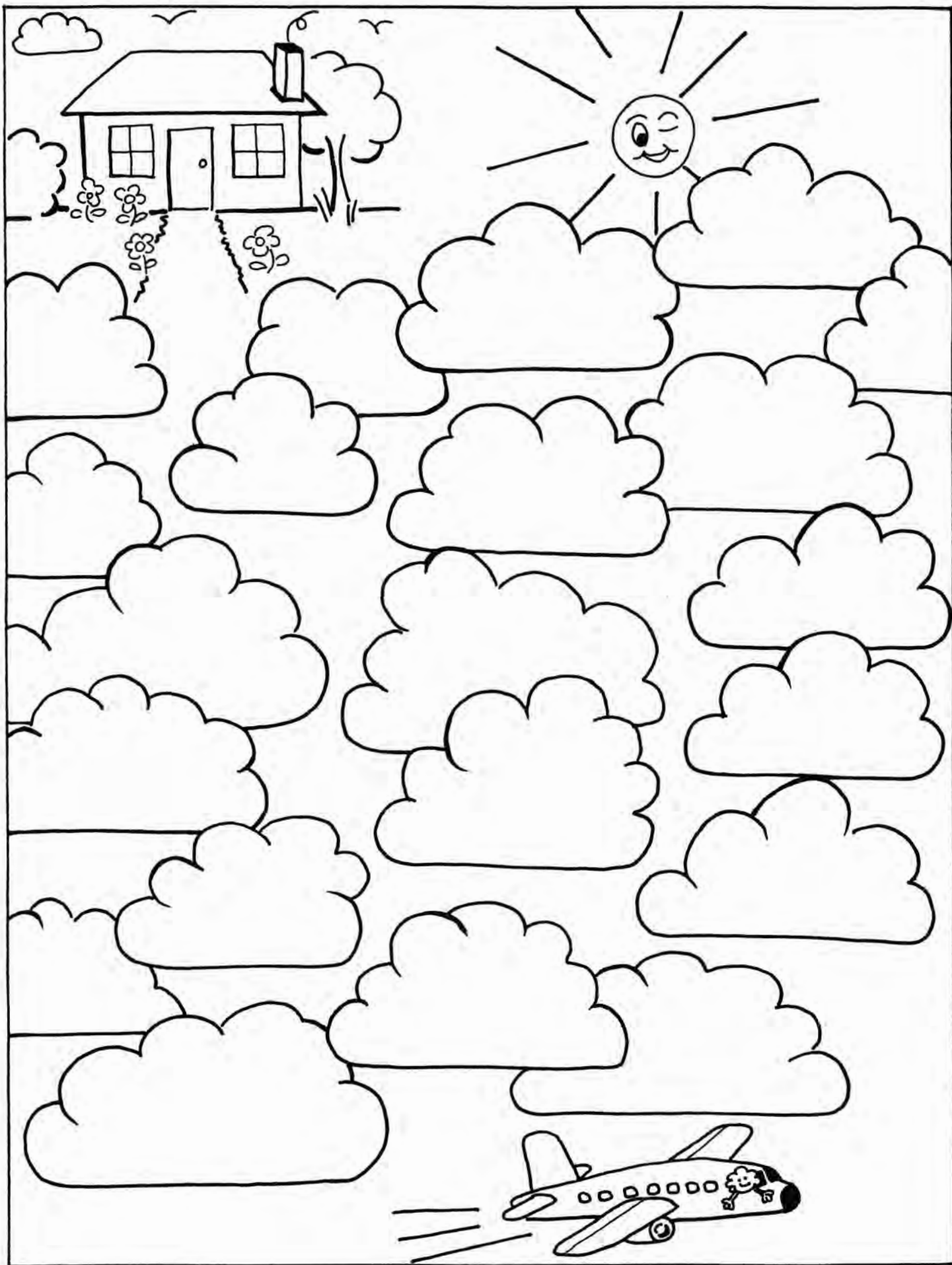
They say goodbye to Snowball and Rustle who will be very happy in their new home.



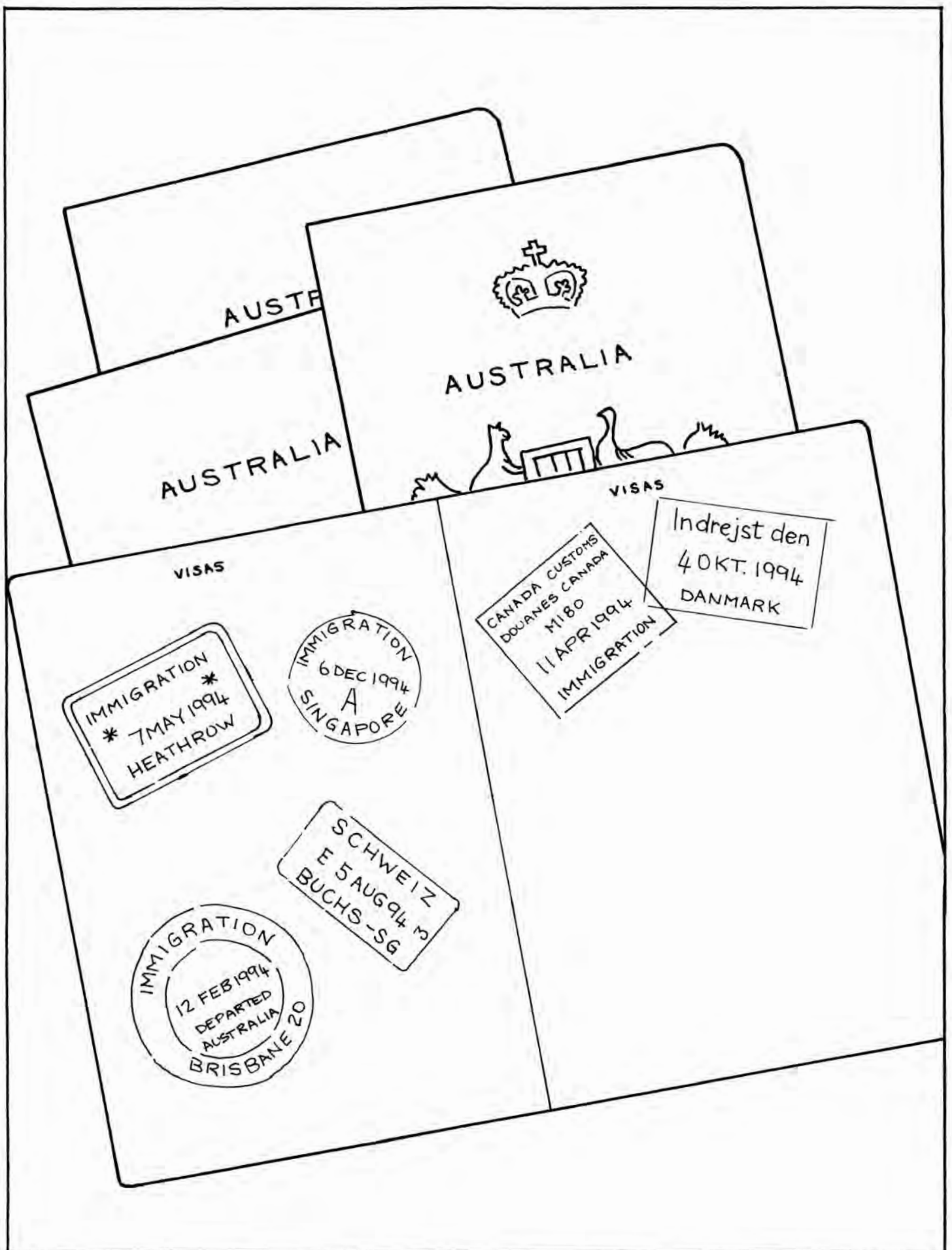
Everyone says goodbye to their friends, their grandparents, uncles, aunts and cousins.



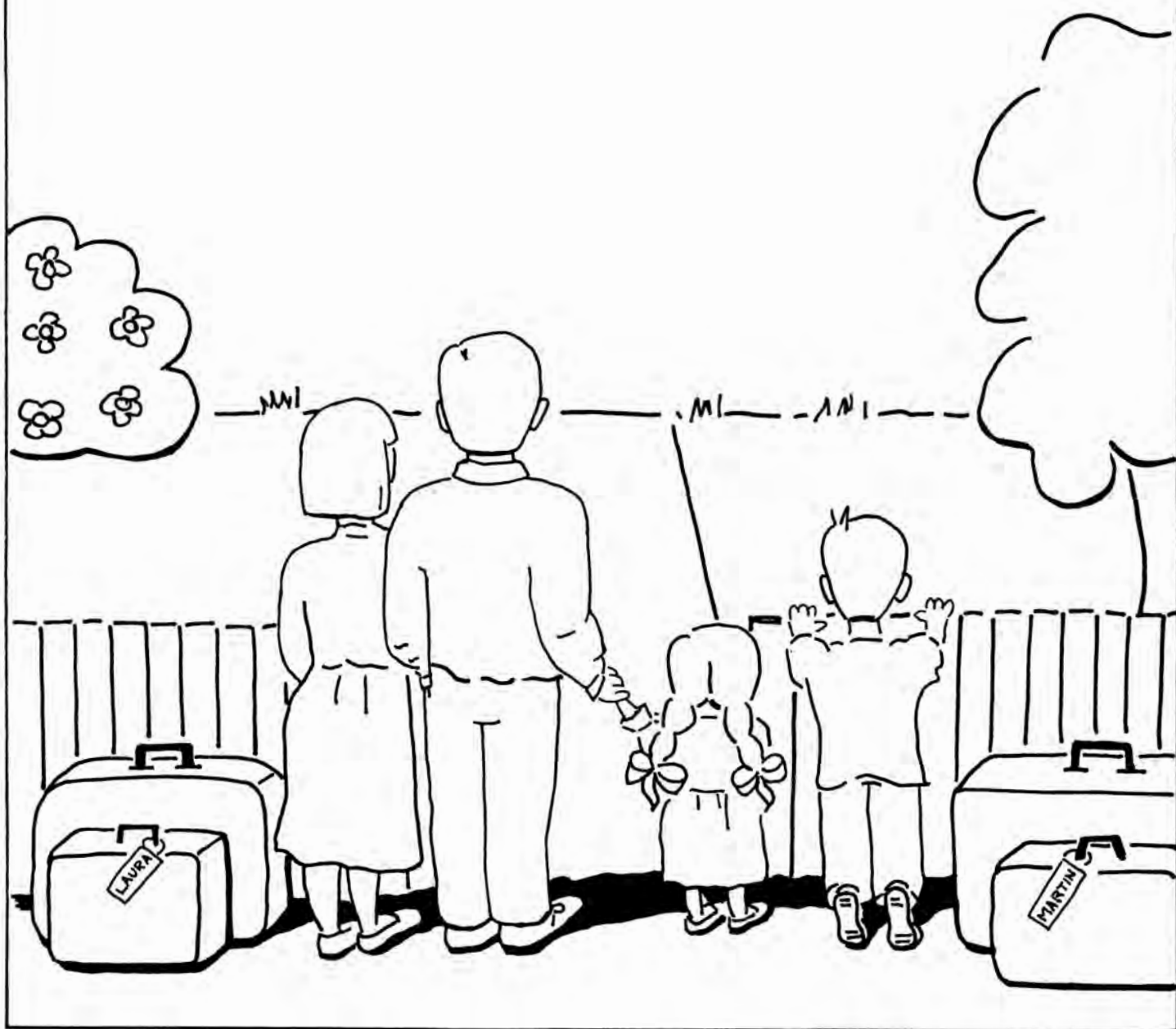
The day comes to go to the airport and get on the plane and head off.
